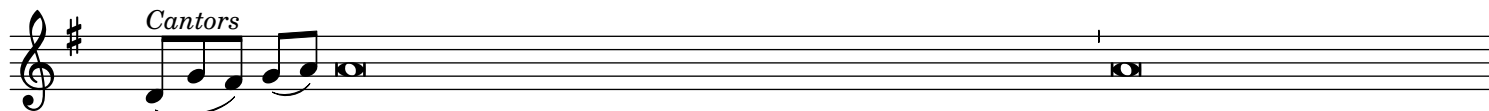

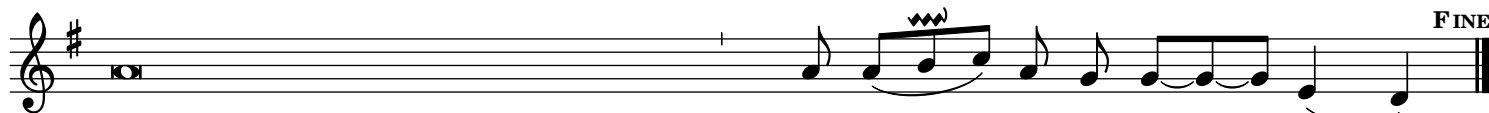

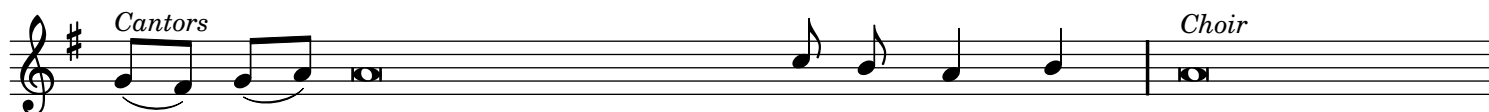

As it was ... and ev - er shall be world with - out end A - men.

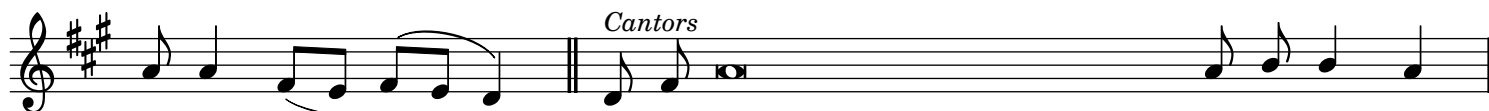
